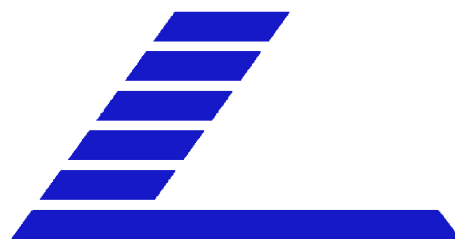

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<b>Cross Country Course</b>	The course is constructed within the Pony Club grounds with many twists and turns. The area is flat, jumps are challenging, solid and inviting and there is a water jump. <b>THE COURSE WILL BE CLOSED FROM MONDAY 1ST SEPTEMBER 2008.</b>																																							
<b>Prizes and Awards</b>	Ribbons to 4 <sup>th</sup> place in each section of the class Prizes will be awarded to the placegetters in the <u>overall</u> class.																																							
<b>Accommodation/ Stalls/Yards/Dogs</b>	A limited number of yards are available on a “first in” basis, free of charge. Camping is allowed on the grounds. <b>NO DOGS ARE PERMITTED ON THE GROUNDS AT THIS EVENT.</b> <b>Please remember to remove hay/manure from all horse yards before leaving.</b>																																							

<b>Refreshments</b>	A canteen will operate throughout the competition. <u>Lunch orders must be in at the canteen before 10am</u>
<b>Jump Judges &amp; Helpers</b>	All competitors must nominate a jump judge or helper per horse entered, or else pay a \$50 helper fee per horse. There are LIMITED "self help" positions available. Helpers MUST be over the age of 15 years
<b>Withdrawals</b>	Please notify the organiser prior to the commencement of the event. To obtain a refund, a Veterinary or Medical certificate MUST be provided within 7 days of the event. A \$10 administration fee will apply.
<b>General</b>	Riders in PCAWA classes must be financial members of the PCAWA, and must wear Pony Club uniform for all phases. Riders must supply their own number holder. These are available for purchase at Saddlery and Stock stores. Medical Armbands must be worn during the cross-country phase; these are available at the office. No rider under 18 years is to be left on the ground without a parent/guardian. Horses/ponies must be 4 years of age or more Wearing a back protector is ADVISABLE during the cross-country phase of the event.
