

PRIVACY POLICY

The King River Horse & Pony Club (Inc) understands that members may have concerns about their privacy and the confidentiality and security of information that the King River Horse & Pony Club (Inc) may obtain about them.

Collection

Personal information is collected by the King River Horse & Pony Club (Inc) for the primary purpose of membership requirements and/or competition purposes. The King River Horse & Pony Club (Inc) collects details such as your name, address, telephone and facsimile numbers, email addresses, gender, age, horse registration details and performances and interests.

The King River Horse & Pony Club (Inc) policy is to protect members' privacy and personal information that it may collect from time to time.

The King River Horse & Pony Club (Inc) has undertaken to comply with the requirements of the Privacy Act, 1988 and the National Privacy Principles included in the Privacy Act (Private Sector) Amendment Act 2000.

National Privacy Principles (NPPs)

There are ten National Privacy Principles which :

- Detail the way personal information should be collected used and disclosed;
- Require organizations to take reasonable steps to keep data accurate and up-to-date, to store data securely and discard unnecessary data;
- Require organizations to be open with individuals about their privacy policies and to publish a privacy policy;
- Require organizations to give access to an individual of his or her personal information on request, except in certain limited circumstances;
- Deal with identifiers and anonymity;
- Restrict the flow of data to foreign countries; and
- Impose stricter regulation on the collection, use and disclosure of sensitive information.

Use & Disclosure

The King River Horse & Pony Club (Inc) will not use or disclose this information for a purpose unrelated to its activities or outside your reasonable expectations unless the King River Horse & Pony Club (Inc) has your agreement or need to meet a legal obligation or authority.

Please note that the publication of results and performances at equestrian events and of statistics relating to these is normal practice in all sports.

You have the right to access your personal information. If you would like to do so, please let us know. You may be required to put your request in writing for security reasons.
