Event rules:	Classes 1-13 will be run under the Pony Club WA Eventing Rules 2022 and amendments. Class 14 will be run under PCWA Hickstead Rules 2022. Entering this event constitutes implicit knowledge and acceptance of these rules.

Entry and Ground fees:	The entry fee for classes 1-13 is \$95.00 per horse/rider combination. Entry fee for class 14 (PC30 Hickstead over one round) is \$60 per horse/rider combination. There will be a compulsory \$10 ground fee for non-KRPC ground members.
Entry submission and payment:	Entries and payment on-line at www.ktrials.com.au . Select 'Riders' and 'Event Select' and follow the prompts. Unpaid entries will not be put in the draw.

Draw:	The draw and assigned helper duties will be posted on Ktrials (www.ktrials.com.au) by Tuesday 22 nd November 2022. Check for updates as times and duties are subject to changes due to withdrawals.
Helper duties:	<i>All riders are expected to nominate a helper over the age of 16 years. There will be limited 'self-help' positions available. These have to be arranged directly with the event Organisers prior to entry. Helper duty preferences submitted will be considered but not guaranteed. Failure to provide a helper may result in elimination and/or exclusion from future events.</i>
Closing date:	<i>Closing date for entries is Monday, 5.00pm, 14th November 2022.</i>
General conditions of entry:	Riders entered in Pony club classes must be current financial members of a Pony Club affiliated with PCWA and compete in full Pony Club uniform. Open Riders must show proof of current Open Rider registration. Riders must meet the Minimum Eligibility Requirements (MER) for the level they have entered. Horse/rider combinations entered in PC105 must have 3 qualifying results in PC95 or EvA95. Horse/rider combinations entered in PC95 must have 2 qualifying results in PC80 or EvA80. [See Rule 13.1.2 Minimum Eligibility Requirements for full details].
Number of entries permitted per rider:	<i>Riders are restricted to TWO rides [horses/ponies] in any PCWA One Day Event.</i> Both horses may be entered in the same class. [See Rule 23 Entries].
Substitutions:	Substitutions are permitted before start of event if accompanied by a veterinary certificate and the replacement mount is eligible under PCWA rules. No substitution of rider is permitted under any circumstances. [See Rule 22 Entries].
Horses Age:	A horses/pony may compete at this event <i>from the beginning of the calendar year in which it turns 5 years.</i> The onus is on the Owner/Rider to provide proof of Age.
Rider Age:	Riders may compete in PC105 classes from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 12 years of age, in the PC95 classes from the beginning of the year in which they turn 11 years of age, in the PC80 classes from the beginning of the year in which they turn 10 years of age, in the PC65 classes from the beginning of the year in which they turn 9 years of age, and in the PC45 classes from the beginning of the year in which they turn 8 years of age.
Dress and Saddlery:	Riders are responsible for knowing the rules regarding wearing rider numbers, horse numbers, correct protective headgear and body protectors. Back numbers and bridle numbers are to be worn in all phases and a back protector is to be worn in the cross country phase. Riders need to refer to Appendix IV <i>Gear Checking Requirements</i> in the Pony Club WA Eventing Rules 2022. Riders must be gear checked before each phase.
Withdrawals:	Withdrawals prior to closing date must be made via Ktrials. Refunds of fees for withdrawals after closing date will be in accordance with PCWA Eventing Rules 2022. All withdrawals or substitutions after closing date must be emailed to the Event Secretary (Barbara.cook@uwa.edu.au).
Prizes and Awards:	All classes: Ribbons to 4 th place; prizes to 3 rd place for each class. Rugs for the overall winner of each height.
Medical and veterinary services:	First Aid services will be provided as per the Minimum Medical Standards for Pony Club Framework. There will be a vet on call for Saturday and a vet on course on Sunday.
Canteen:	Canteen will be open during the competition from mid-morning to mid-afternoon.
Horse yards:	There are ample yards available at no additional cost.
Dogs:	Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
Closure of cross country course:	<i>The cross country course will be closed to all competitors from Sunday 30 October 2022.</i> Any temporary closures prior to this date need to be strictly adhered to for safety reasons.
Camping and parking:	Camping will be permitted on the grounds. Parking is allowed in designated areas.
